"Kentucky Mountain Home Place Information"

Community Health Worker, Kathy Hamilton, presented information on the Kentucky Mountain Home Place services. She provided those present with a handout explaining that they can provide free health information, health coaching for clients and family members, chronic disease self-management, diabetes self-management, reduced or no cost medications, eye exams and glasses, hearing aids at reduced rates, reduced fee for dental services and low cost dentures, sliding fee referrals for doctor visits, enroll or re-enroll for Medicaid & KCHIP, Medicare D information, among other things. The handout also contained her contact information to obtain additional information.

**Health Report:**

Ms. Taulbee presented all those present with a handout documenting medical statistics for each program this year. Mr. Jenkins commented that Floyd and Johnson Counties numbers looked good.

**Disability Services Report:**

Disability Services Manager Debbie McKenzie presented members with the disability numbers for each program while identifying whether the child(ren) fell under being autistic, non categorical developmental delay, speech language, other impairments, visual impairment, multiple disability, and hearing impairment. Mrs. McKenzie noted that these numbers did not reflect a comprehensive amount of children being served with disabilities. She said many children may fall under KERA instead of Head Start and would reflect in those numbers.

**Nutrition Services Report:**

Nutrition Manager Lori Howard presented members with the nutrition report and explained it in detail.

**Mental Health Services Report:**

Mental Health Manager Pam Hereford explained that we still have 5 licensed mental health professionals through a contract with Mountain Comprehensive Care Center and school based therapists on hand. Our program is continuing to use the second step curriculum. Members reviewed the mental health statistics without questions.

**Dental Letter:**

Mr. Jenkins noted that dental treatment in our area is a concern since only 2 pediatric dentists accept the medical card. He drafted a proposed letter to recruit more pediatric dentists to the area. The letter he intends to send out to different dental schools.

Height/Weight Comparison:

Mrs. Howard presented members with a comparative growth assessment for the last three years. She noted that staff are supposed to be weighing and measuring children with their shoes off. Member Ash'Leigh Adams suggested purchasing scales for each school if apparent discrepancies continued.
